

Professor Newman is currently on the Fulbright Roster of Senior Specialists. Fulbright funding is available for engaging him in short term (2 to 6 week) international academic activities such as lectures, short courses, workshops, or curriculum development.

According to the Fulbright web pages, the Senior Specialist Program has three goals,

- To increase participation of leading U.S. scholars in academic exchanges
- To encourage new activities that go beyond traditional Fulbright activities
- To promote increased connections between U.S. and non-U.S. institutions

Applications for the Fulbright Senior Specialists Program are accepted on a rolling basis, and peer review of applications is conducted eight times per year.
